Our History

The Willoughby family has long been home to pioneering figures whose achievements shape the character of Birdsall House. Hugh Willoughby lost his life in 1553 while seeking the North East Passage, embodying the family's spirit of exploration. Francis Willoughby (1635–1672), a naturalist and early member of the Royal Society, catalogued hundreds of plant and animal species, anticipating Darwin's work by two centuries. Nesbit Willoughby (1777–1849), one of the boldest officers in British naval history, is even said to have inspired characters in the Hornblower novels. Their stories, alongside collections of art, antiques and furniture, form the rich heritage of the estate.

Birdsall House stands on the site of an ancient monastic settlement and has evolved through centuries of family stewardship by one family. Birdsall House was first built as a Tudor dwelling by the Sotheby family. A chance snowstorm in 1719 found Thomas Willoughby seeking shelter at Birdsall and subsequently marrying the heiress daughter Elizabeth. Together they transformed the house into a Georgian residence which later grew through additions ranging from 18th century State Rooms to Victorian work by Anthony Salvin. Having weathered the challenges of the post war era, Birdsall emerged as the family's principal home and remains so today. Under the stewardship of the Willoughby family the estate continues to thrive, welcoming guests for weddings, filming, country pursuits and more, ensuring that Birdsall's remarkable history remains a living, breathing story.

Staying at Birdsall

Birdsall is the perfect weekend wedding venue, with exclusive use for your entire stay. Enjoy a pre-wedding dinner with your closest family and friends, or a post-wedding brunch. Our Bridal Suite is perfect for getting ready, complete with a spacious dressing room and large bathroom. Plus, we have five stunning en-suite bedrooms for your guests.

Need more space? We work closely with Langton Hall (just two miles away), which offers exclusive self-catering accommodation for 56 guests. A minibus can be available to transport guests between the two venues.

The pictuesque market town of Malton, 4 miles away, is also host to several hotels and there is also plenty of accommodation available nearby through AirB'n'B.

The Dining Room

Capacity | 150 Seated (Ceremony) 80 Seated (Dining)

A perfect room for a stunning ceremony, a drinks reception or mid size wedding breakfast. Alternatively, you can use the Dining Room on the night before your wedding for a family dinner or the day after your wedding for a survival brunch.





The Long Hall

Capacity | 50 Standing

The Long Hall is the room where guests enter the house and the perfect place to gather before indoor ceremonies or host receptions, especially if it is cold outside. Grand but relaxed it exudes the warmth or our family home.





The Ballroom

Capacity | 150 Seated (Ceremony) 110 Seated (Dining)

Our grandest reception room, filled with natural light, is ideal for large ceremonies, receptions, or your wedding breakfast. When paired with the Oval Room, we can seat up to 150 guests for a spectacular feast.





The Oval Room

Capacity | 60 Seated (Ceremony) 48 Seated (Dining)

This impressive reception room with family collected paintings and furniture is perfect for smaller ceremonies, cosy receptions or wedding breakfasts. The piano is tuned and ready to play!





The Verandah

Capacity | 300 Seated (In Front of House)

Our Verandah, on the front of the house, is a spectacular site for ceremonies as well as for receptions in inclement weather, giving shelter to guests from sun and showers.





The Gardens

Capacity | 300 Seated (On The Lawns or Within a Marquee)

The gardens surrounding the house are very extensive and can cater for quintessentially English garden receptions or host magnificent marquees, as well as being the perfect backdrop for your photos.





The Old Kitchens

The best parties always happen in the kitchen and Birdsall House takes that to heart. After the formalities in the elegant rooms upstairs, the celebration shifts up a gear as you and your guests head down to The Old Kitchens, the house's atmospheric, prohibition-style nightclub and bar hidden beneath the house.



This characterful warren of rooms offers something for everyone. Guests can wander to the cocktail bar, sink into comfortable sofas to catch up with friends, help themselves to grazing platters in The Pantry, or head straight to the dancefloor to shimmy the night away.

A striking contrast to the refined elegance above, The Old Kitchens were once the bustling working core of the estate. Today, they have been transformed into an opulent speakeasy, rich with velvet textures, moody lighting and intriguing secret spaces. The result is an immersive, intimate and high-energy setting - an unforgettable backdrop for the part of the day where the celebrations really begin.

Set within Birdsall's rolling parkland, St Mary's Church offers a timeless, sacred setting. Part of the Parish of West Buckrose, it welcomes ceremonies of up to 200 guests in serene surroundings

The Dining Room

Framed by the beautiful interiors of Birdsall House, the Dining Room hosts ceremonies for up to 150 guests, with smaller gatherings held before the fireplace or Georgian windows overlooking the front lawn and The Old Ruins.

The Old Ruins

Set on the front lawns of Birdsall, the Old Ruins offer a striking ceremony setting within the reamins of an 11th-century Church. Surrounding by the original arched walls and bell tower, this unique venue can host up to 300 guests.

Wedding Ceremony

Once you are ready, you and your bridal party come downstairs for photographs with your family, capturing quiet, meaningful moments together before heading off to be married in one of our beautiful ceremonial settings — from the historic ruins, to St Mary's Church, or within the timeless elegance of Birdsall itself.

Drinks Reception

After the ceremony, as newlyweds, you return to your friends and family for celebratory drinks on the lawn. While your wedding photographs are being taken, guests are free to relax, mingle and enjoy a leisurely game of croquet in the sunshine.

Wedding Breakfast


BY CAR

Birdsall is 20 miles east of York and 4.5 miles south of Malton, YO17. There is plenty of parking at Birdsall House for events and visits. Please let us know in advance if you would like spaces reserved for accessible parking. Navigate to us using the map here, or by using the platform What3words:///brothers.dustbin.

BYTRAIN

Malton is the nearest train station to Birdsall and York is the closest major train station. Taxis are also available from both stations but should be booked in advance. There is very little mobile phone reception at Birdsall so please book taxi's in advance of arrival and departure.

BY AIR

Our nearest airports are Leeds Bradford and Humberside Airport. Larger airports for long haul flights are Manchester and Newcastle. Private aircraft can arrive at Leeds East Airport which can deal with European flights and passport control. Helicopters can land at Birdsall House and we can give pilots landing information.
